We need your help.....

Lodi Police Department detectives are continuing to investigate a homicide that occurred on the afternoon of September 25th, 2016.

On this date at about 1:45 pm Lodi Police Department and Lodi Fire Department responded to a structure fire in the 1500 block of West Vine Street. After the Lodi Fire Department gained control of the fire, a deceased male was located inside of the residence. The San Joaquin County Coroner's Office later determined during an autopsy that the male located in the fire was stabbed to death. The death was determined to be a homicide, which occurred prior to the fire being started.

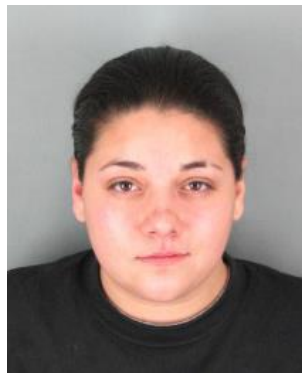

The vehicle is believed to be a 1997-2003, red or maroon, Ford F-150 pickup truck with a regular cab, long bed, and a rolling bed cover.
